Bolivia: White Browed Hawk

Java: Green Peafowl

West Papua: **Long-tailed**

Pygmy Possum

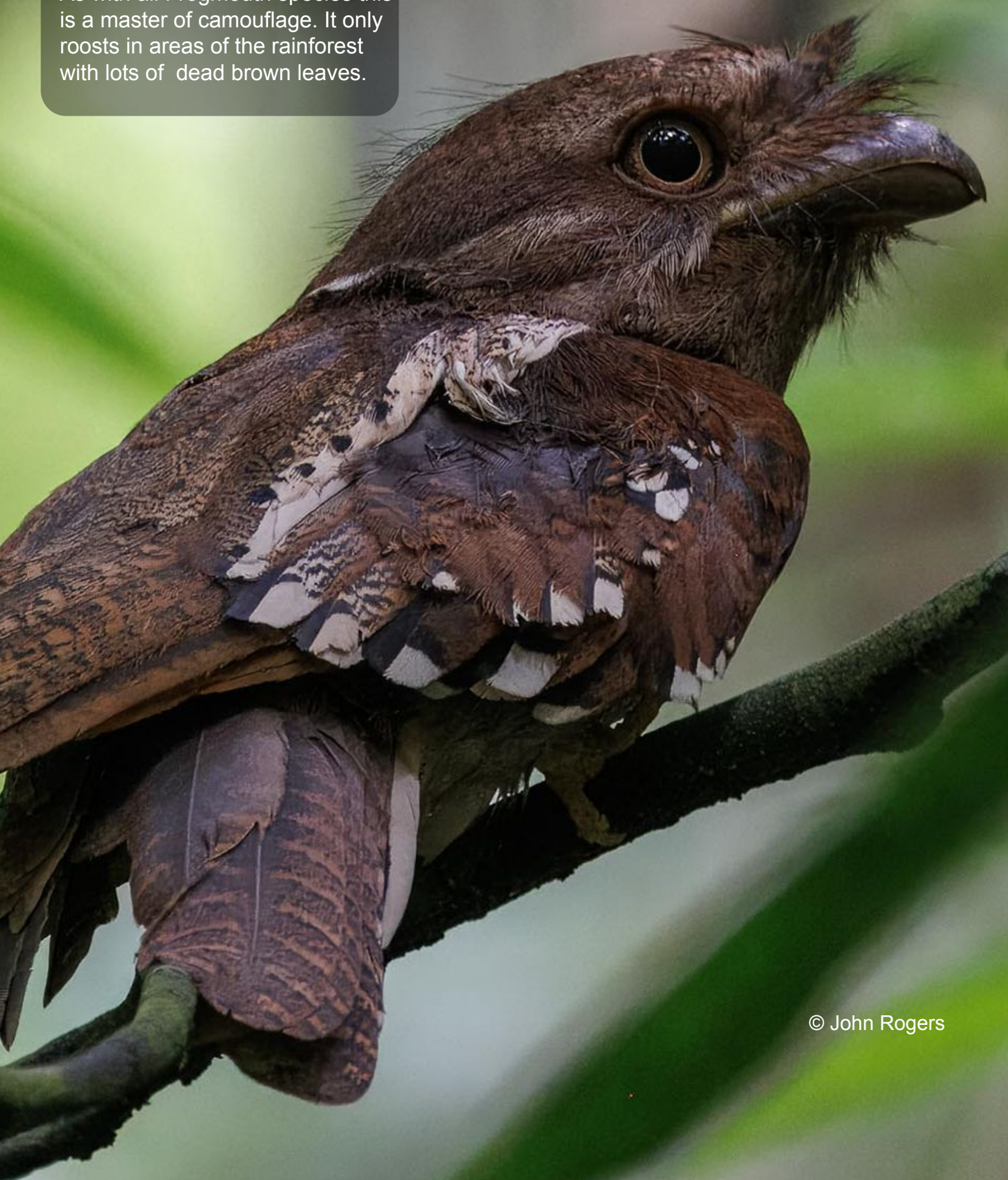
The tiny Long-tailed Pygmy Possum is restricted to montane rainforests in Papua and northern Australia and is both nocturnal and arboreal.

Philippines-Bohol: **Philippine Frogmouth**

As with all Frogmouth species this is a master of camouflage. It only roosts in areas of the rainforest with lots of dead brown leaves.
